Passaic, NJ- March 14, 2007- In recent events, the Chi Chapter (Cornell University) of Lambda Theta Phi Latin Fraternity, Inc. has been suspended and is under investigation for allegations of hazing. Currently, the investigation is still being conducted. The Chapter and the National Board are fully cooperating with University Officials to resolve this matter.

This is an unfortunate and isolate incident which has occurred. The National Executive Board is working hard to rectify this matter with its members. Lambda Theta Phi is a non-hazing organization and fully endorses and abides by the "Resolution Against Hazing" as developed by the North American Inter-Fraternity Conference, Inc. (NIC).

During the week of April 16 – 20, 2007, the National Executive Board has established this week as "National Hazing Awareness Week." The goal is to educate and expose the myth and reality of hazing. All Chapters/Colonies will be required to plan, hold and participate in a campus wide activity. Various activities, such as, a speaker forums, workshops and roundtables will be held to meet this initiative. The result will have educated over 1000 students throughout the country on hazing.

Founded in 1975 at Kean University in Union, New Jersey, Lambda Theta Phi Latin Fraternity, Inc. is the first national recognized Greek-letter organization founded as a Latin Fraternity. The membership of Lambda Theta Phi is open to all college men who support its values of scholarship, respect for all culture, community service, and the advancement and fair treatment of Latinos. Lambda Theta Phi was the first Latin Fraternity to be recognized by the North-American Inter-Fraternity Conference (NIC) and today, has over 90 Chapters and Colonies in, Arizona, California, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Illinois, Maryland, Michigan, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia, West Virginia, and Wisconsin.
